In The Forest

The Hunter Shooting The Deer

The Hunter:

- **Saw The Deer**
- **And**
- **Decided that**
- **He Should Shoot it**

The Second Hunter Looked On

The Hunter

Did Not Want

The Deer

To Get Away

The **Hunter**:

- Prepared **His Bow**
- With **The Arrow in it**
- In Order To
- **Shoot The Deer**

*The **Hunter**
Did Not **Want**
The **Deer**
To **Get Away***

*The **Whole Time**
The **Deer**
Was **Standing Quiet**
Under **A Tree***

Shooting The Arrow At The Deer

So The **Hunter**:

- Aimed **His Arrow**
- And **Shot it**

*The **Whole Time**
The **Deer**
Was **Standing Quiet**
Under **A Tree***

*The **Hunter**
Had **Shot His Arrow**
At **The Deer***

After To Shoot The Arrow

After The **Hunter**:

- **Shot His Arrow**
- **At The Deer**
- He **Looked Up**

*The **Hunter**:*

*Looked **To See**
If **The Arrow** was
Going **At The Deer***

He Looked To See:

- If The **Deer**
- Was Still **Under**
- **The Tree**

The Whole Time
The Deer
Was Standing Quiet
Under A Tree

Apparently:

- The **Deer**
- **Did Not See**
- The **Hunter**

When:

The Hunter Looked
He Saw The Deer
Still Under
The Tree

But:

What The Hunter Saw
Under The Tree
After He Had Shot His Arrow
He Could Not Believe His Eyes

The Hunter Was Shocked

What The Hunter Saw Under The Tree

When The **Hunter Looked:**

- **Under The Tree**
- He **Saw** that
- He Had **Made**
- **A Mistake**

The Deer that:

The Hunter
Had in His Mind

*The **Deer** that:*

*He Had
Shot The Arrow At
Was **Not A Deer***

*The **Hunter**
Had Made A Mistake*

What The **Hunter** Saw:

- **Under The Tree**
- Was **Not Really A Deer**
- Was A **Cow**

*Omg
Thought The **Hunter**
He Had Made A Mistake*

*The **Deer**
Under The Tree
Was **Not Really A Deer**
Was A **Cow***

*The **Hunter** Accidentally Shot A **Cow***

The Hunter's Disbelief

When The **Hunter**:

- **Thought** About This
- What **He** Saw
- He **Could Not Believe His Eyes**

*He **Saw** that:*

*The **Deer**
That:He Had
Shot The Arrow At
Was **Not A Deer***

*The **Animal** that He
Shot His Arrow at:*

*The **Animal** that He
Hunted
Which He **Thought Was A Deer**
Was A **Cow***

He Felt Bad

Because:

- It Was **Not A Deer**
- But A **Cow**
- He **Felt Bad**

He Felt that:

*He Had Made
A Terrible Mistake*

Never Hurt A Cow in India

The **Hunter Saw:**

- That The **Deer**
- Was Actually
- A **Cow**

He Had:

*Shot His Arrow at it
And It Was Dead*

In **India:**

- They **Love The Cow**

*Ever Since
A Long Time
In India
They Love The Cow*

The **Cow:**

- Which is An **Animal**
- Is **Sacred** and **Holy** for **Indians**

So:

*It is Very Wrong
To Hurt A Cow in India*

The **Hunter**:

- **Realized** that
- Since He Had
- **Shot The Arrow At The Deer**
- That He Had **Made A Mistake**

*The **Deer** Was Actually A Cow*

*The **Hunter** Also **Realized** that:*

*Since He Had
Shot The Arrow
That
He Could Never
Call It Back*

What Was:

And Not A **Deer***

*The **Hunter** Had
Come To The **Forest**
To **Hunt** A **Deer***

Instead:

*A **Cow** Was **Dead***

The Hunter:

- **Had Learned A Lesson**

*The **Hunter's Lesson** Was:*

*He Should
Be Careful
And **Be Sure**
Before He
Does An Action*

*He Had **Learned** that:*

*He Could Not
Call Back An Action
After He Had **Committed** it*

*They Were **Both:***

Sad

Had **Shot** A **Cow***

*He Could Not
